



Parents/Carers and Spectators Code of Conduct

Parents/Carers and Spectators have a great influence on children's enjoyment and success in football. All children play football because they first and foremost love the game – it's fun.

To demonstrate best practice, I will;

- Celebrate effort and good play in training and from both sides during games.
- Always respect the referee and coaches and encourage the players to do the same.
- Stay behind the touchline and within the Designated Spectators' Area (where provided).
- When players make mistakes, offer them encouragement to try again next time.
- Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour in person or online.
- Avoid coaching from the touchlines.
- Give attention to each of the children involved in football not just the most talented.
- Escalate any issues not able to be dealt with by the coaching team to the clubs Welfare Officer.
- Keep personal details up to date on Future Lions.

I understand that if I do not follow the code, I may be:

- Issued with a verbal warning or asked to leave.
- Required to meet with the club committee, league or CFA WO.
- Obligated to undertake an FA Education Course.
- Requested to not attend future games, suspended or have my membership removed.
- Required to leave the club with any dependants and/or issued a fine.
