Our Community Teams

We have an ever growing grassroots football community that Kettering Town F.C. Community Trust oversees. Currently our football teams run from U7's up to U13's for mixed teams which play each week in the Kettering Weetabix league, and U10's to U13's for girls only teams, which play every week in the Macron Northamptonshire Women's & Girl's Football League. We run all of our teams with a football for all ethos, where players have a safe environment to grow and develop not just in football, but everyday life skills.

With all of these teams, we have over 200 youth football players from our local community that we cater for, We make sure to stock all of our teams with enough football's for one each, to maximise ball time, cones, bibs, kit bag and a fully stocked first aid baa.

Holiday Camps

We run 6 Holiday Camps a year, catering to any child from 5 years old to 14. Summer Holidays,

October Half Term, Christmas Break, February Half Term, Easter Break and May Half Term. Our camps run 10-3pm Monday to Friday over the school holidays, all out of our Kettering Town FC Home around. Latimer Park.




Wildcots
