1.0 What data do we collect?

We receive, collect, and store any information you enter on our website or provide to us by email or data forms. This may include names, email addresses, phone numbers, passwords, and street addresses. In addition to this we collect Internet protocol (IP) address used to connect your computer to the internet.

We may use software tools (such as Google Analytics) to measure and collect session information, including page response times, length of visits to certain pages and page interactions.

We also store all information relating to comments, feedback, reviews, and recommendations.

We also reserve the right to contact friend referrals made by current customers.

2.0 How do we collect information?

When you complete a booking enquiry form, or review form we collect this personal information. This data will only be used for the intended purpose. We may share reviews on social media pages.

3.0 Why do we collect such personal information?

We gather information though such software as Google Analytics to understand where and how our client base is accessing and using our website. It is also used to ensure the site is meeting the needs of its users and if improvements need to be made.

We also collect data to offer the services in which we provide, such as bookings, email subscriptions and alerts. Your data is also used so we can contact visitors and users with general or personalised service-related notices and promotional messages.

We may also use information gathered on our site to create statistical data which will be used to improve our website and services offered. Data is also gathered to comply with applicable laws, regulations, and guidelines.





4.0 How do we store, use, share and disclose our site visitors' personal information?

We will not sell or share your data with any third parties for marketing purposes.

We will store your data securely for only use for their intended purposes unless stated otherwise, such as in-house marketing.
